SUBJECT: INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS: DRIVER EDUCATION, GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Driver Education

A driver education course may be offered under the conditions set forth by the New York State Education Department.

Gifted and Talented Students

The Board of Education will provide appropriate educational programs for students identified as being gifted and talented.

Physical Education Class

All students, except those with medical excuses, shall participate in physical education in accordance with the Commissioner's Regulations. Any student whose condition precludes participation in a regular program shall be provided with adaptive physical education approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Alternative Physical Education/Athletes

The Board of Education recognizes that athletes who are members of interscholastic athletic teams are attending and participating in a program of physical education instruction which is at least comparable with the fitness portion of the physical education program and demands a large time commitment. Hence, an option shall be provided for those who wish to do so to have their participation on the team be in lieu of their participation in a physical education class. This option shall be available only for the period of time which they are on the team.
