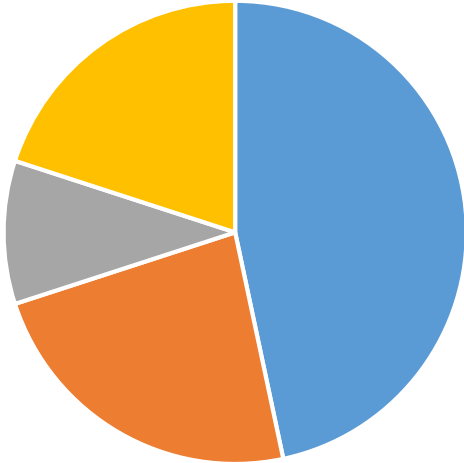
Pre-Kindergarten Year 1

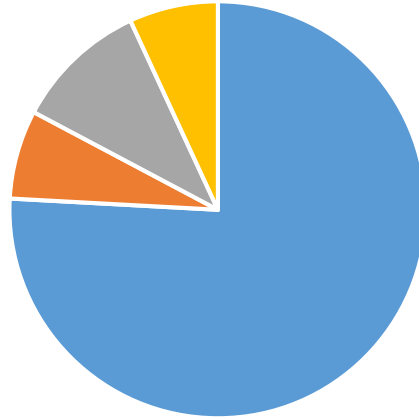

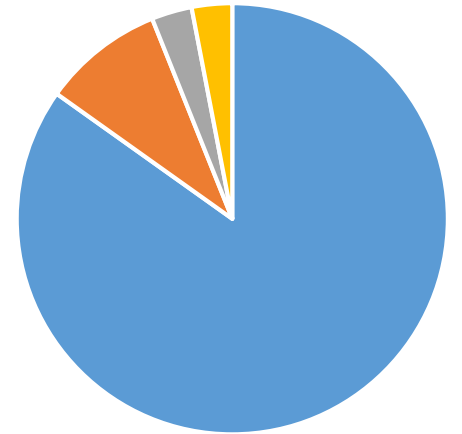

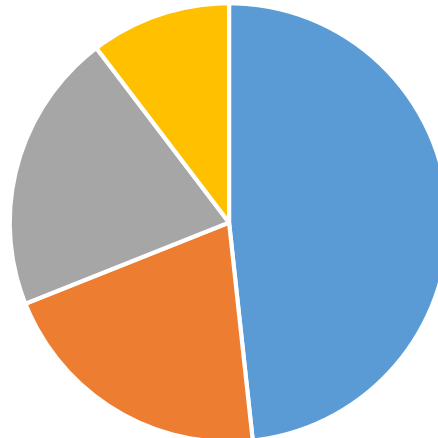

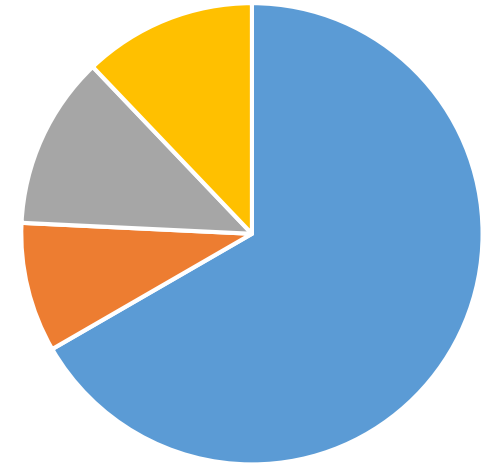

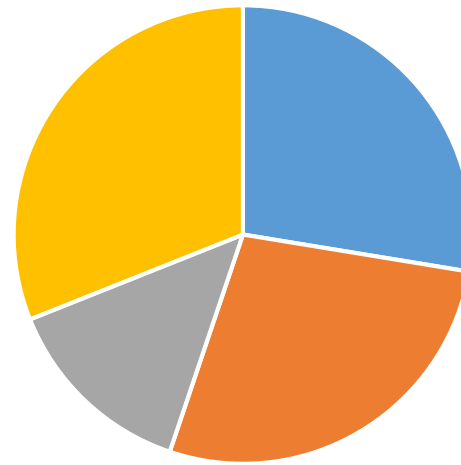
Lower Case Letter Recognition

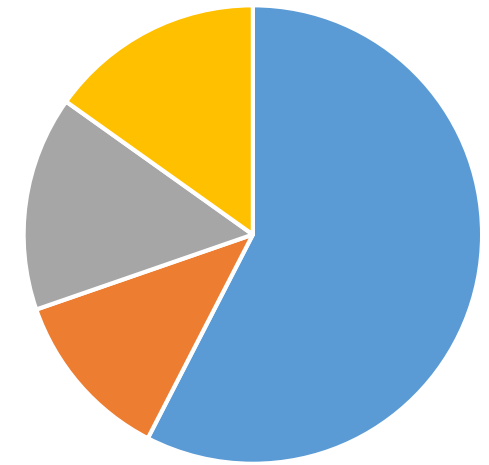

Pre-K to UPK Expansion

- Federal Stimulus Funds
 - Full-day only
 - 4 year old students
 - Up to 72 students
- Preference for half-day students and waitlist
 - 51 students from the original half-day program committed to full-day
 - Four (4) students will be 5 years old when the program start
 - Funding for 68 students



Pre-K to UPK Expansion

- District Wide Lottery Application
 - 28 students applied
 - 21 students were selected
 - 7 students on the waitlist
- Parents ranked location choices
- Families notified week of 6/28
- Registration: July 6th and 8th
- Pre-K teachers will meet throughout the summer

- Program begins on Thursday, September 9, 2021
- Transportation by parents
- No specials
- Eat in cafeteria
- Recess
- Class size 18 students
