The Power of UPK!

"An ongoing independent evaluation has found that during the year before kindergarten, Pre-K children develop literacy, language, and math skills faster than non-participating children. Gains made by Pre-K children are 37 to 176 percent greater than those of non-Pre-K children and persist into the elementary grades."







- End of year meeting with each family








"Play-based instruction addresses both the cognitive and the emotional aspects of children's development (Letourneau and Sobel 2020)"

Play Continuum- Stages of Play									
	Onlooker Behavior: Child engages in deliberate watching; may ask questions but doesn't attempt to join the play.	Solitary Play: Child chooses to play and is absorbed in his/her own play.	Parallel Play: Child plays next to another child; may share materials, little or no interaction.	Associative Play: Children choose to play together/do the same activity, sharing materials but without planning or establishing the "rules"	Cooperative/Social Play: Two or more children plan, discuss and negotiate roles and dramatic scenarios, are able to compromise and forego individual goals to continue group play.



Upper Case Letter Identification




Fall 2022 Kindergarten Upper Case Letter Identification



Fall 2021 UPK Lower Case Letter Identification




Fall 2022 Kindergarten Lower Case Letter Identification


