The 2022 Capital Project Vote will be held in four days, 6 a.m. – 9 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 13, in the District Office building, 71 Lyell Ave.

Over the last few months, we have made a concerted effort to provide all of the project details to our staff, families and community. We also want to encourage voter turnout.

We ask anyone who is eligible to make time to cast your ballot. Voters must be a United States citizen, 18 years or older and live in the Spencerport district for at least 30 days. Resident voters do not need to own property. Parking will be designated in the upper lot for ease of access.

### Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK)

Although Spencerport's Pre-K program is relatively new, we know that it has had a profound impact on the academic and social emotional growth of participating students.

Now in its third year, our Pre-K program is accepting applications through the end of December. Applications may be found on the district website, and we have provided a short video that highlights the benefits for eligible children. Currently, we have a Pre-K classroom in each building and the district follows a lottery system based on the applications we receive.



Spencerport will livestream the Pre-K lottery on Wednesday, January 4, 2023, and additional information will be posted on our website. Parents of eligible Pre-K students are encouraged to apply and ask that you contact Dr. Sumara Case (349-5136) with any questions or if you need assistance.
