2. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

2.1 Mr. Crumb recommended that April 27, 2015 be designated as a K-8 instructional day for students. This date originally had been set aside as a Rating Day with no school only for K-8 students to provide designated time for teachers to score assessments. However with fewer assessments taken, we anticipate that we can accomplish scoring without the loss of an instructional day for students. He therefore recommended April 27, 2015 as a normal, full-day session for all students.

Additionally, Mr. Crumb recommended that Tuesday, June 23, 2015 be the last K-5 student day for the 2014-15 school year. This is one-day shorter than published and is reflective of our past practice when we have met or exceeded the 180-day requirement for student days.

Motion was made by Mr. Zale and seconded by Mr. Gibbardo to adjourn the meeting at 6:11 p.m.


