7.1 Capital Project Update

Mr. Crumb introduced representatives from Campus Construction and Labella Associates to provide an update on our Capital Project. Mr. Donahue from Campus noted that this past summer's work went well without any claims of injury. He reported that spaces have been delivered as scheduled. He also noted many of the site improvements, mechanical upgrades and improvements in the restrooms, cafeterias and centrums. Some spaces are still under construction according to plan and punch lists are being developed and attended to. Mr. Short from Labella reinforced that some of the projects that were forecasted to take longer to complete are still on track. He also noted that the structural remediation at the main entrance of the high school was completed successfully and final brickwork is the only portion of that project that is not completed. Also at the high school, a change order to mill and re-surface all of the main entrance is completed and turned out well. A final note was made that we will be through approximately 90% of the project by next spring. A question was raised on our budget for the project and it was shared that we are in a very good position and both Campus and Labella are in the process of reconciling this.

Mr. Crumb shared his appreciation of the team of contractors that we are working with on this project.




