

ANNUAL DISTRICT MEETING
OF THE SPENCERPORT CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

May 15, 2012
Spencerport, NY

On Tuesday, May 15 2012 from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. E.D.S.T., the Annual District Meeting of the qualified voters of the Spencerport Central School District (Towns of Ogden, Gates, Greece and Parma), Monroe County, New York, was held to vote for the 2012-13 School Budget, and Board of Education members in the Board of Education Room at the Administration Building, room E2B at the Munn Elementary and room E13 at the Taylor Elementary.

Michael Nau, Robert Collins, and John Steeves reported as Board of Elections inspectors and Bonnie Freville, Deb Ferraro, and Barbara Strine reported as the meeting co-chairpersons. The election inspectors and the vote chairpersons inspected the voting machines and made them ready for voting.

At 6:00 a.m. E.D.S.T. the meeting was called to order by the respective co-chairperson, Michael Nau and he turned the meeting over to the District Clerk of the Spencerport Central School District, Daniel Milgate. Mr. Milgate and the vote co-chairperson declared the polls open for those who wished to vote upon the following propositions:

**PROPOSITION NO. 1:
2012-13 School Budget**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING
RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED:**

Approval of the budget in the amount of **\$69,026,404** presented by the Board of Education for 2012-13.

**PROPOSITION NO. 2:
BUS PURCHASES &
FACILITIES
VEHICLES**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED TO
WIT:**

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Spencerport Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of four (4) facilities vehicles at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$195,000 and nine (9) school buses at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$1,068,012, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$1,263,012, less trade-in value, if any, and to appropriate and expend from the existing bus purchase reserve fund \$321,331 for a

portion of such costs, and that the balance of such costs, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$941,681, which may be reduced by any trade-in amount received, estimated to be \$107,600, shall be issued.

**PROPOSITION NO. 3:
RECONSTRUCTION
AND EQUIPPING OF
EXISTING SCHOOL
BUILDINGS AND
FACILITIES**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED TO
WIT:**

Shall the proposition set forth in the legal notice of this annual voter meeting, authorizing reconstruction and equipping of existing school buildings and facilities, site and incidental improvements, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$9,800,000; with the expenditure of \$1,975,000 from the existing capital reserve fund for such costs, the issuance of up to \$7,825,000 of debt obligations of the School District to finance the balance of such costs, and the levy of a tax in annual installments therefor, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor, all as more fully described in said notice, be approved?

The polls remained open until 9:00 p.m. E.D.S.T. May 15, 2012 at which time Mr. Daniel Milgate, District Clerk, and the vote co-chairperson declared the polls closed.
