Did not install power roof vents on buses.  \$31,410 increase for Orton - Gillingham professional development for 28 staff members to gain knowledge of the science of reading, enhance word recognition skills, understand how ELL students can best learn English to aid in supporting the academic needs of the students due to lost learning time from COVID19.  \$26,000 increase for the Thought Exchange platform to use for staff and community surveys for strategic planning and stimulus funding stakeholder input.  \$56,175 increase for Panorama Education's Student Success platform including behavior, coursework, attendance, behavior analytics reporting, student, teacher, staff and family surveying.  \$47,650 increase for additional hours from Clinical Associates of the Finger Lakes for related services for students with IEPs or 504s due to shortage of qualified staff.  \$21,660 increase for Therapy Travelers for psychologist services from February 2022 to May 2022 at Spencerport High School and Canal View Elementary School to support the social emotional needs of the students due to the mental impact of COVID19 and to meet IEP requirements due to staff shortages.  \$6,739 increase for Troxel Communications for installation of interactive flat panels throughout the classrooms to cast from laptops to the flat panel to address instructional needs for virtual learning.  \$33,647 increase for Workfit Medical Staffing to provide medical personnel to conduct COVID 19 testing per NYS requirements for 20-21 and 21-22.
